CJ was born December 31, 1990, in Emporia, KS to James and Donna (Jorgensen) Madison. He was raised in Howard, KS alongside his brother, Marc. He graduated from West Elk High School in the class of 2009.

CJ started playing sports when he was just 4 years old, and it became an important part of his life. Throughout high school, he was active in track, basketball, wrestling, and football. He was the quarterback for his high school football team starting his freshmen year and continued through his senior year.

He had been stationed in Fort Benning, GA, and was getting ready to report to Fort Campbell in just a few days. He was excited about the next chapter in his Army life.
