Allen H. Barnhart, 77, of Altoona, Kansas, passed away on Wednesday, April 30, 2025, at St. Luke's Hospice House in Kansas City, Missouri, surrounded by his loving family.

Born on December 23, 1947, in Parsons, Kansas, Allen was a 1965 graduate of Erie High School. He dedicated over 50 years of his life to operating heavy equipment, owner and operator of Barnhart Dozer Service, and notably holding the contract for the Wilson County landfill until his retirement.
