Anita Lynn Crawshaw, 86, of Fredonia, passed away on Saturday, January 10, 2026, at Fredonia Regional Hospital. Anita was born on November 18, 1939, in Garnett, KS., the daughter of Vernon Dale and Willa Bella (Fogleman) Borrer.
