



## Ann Toni Michelle Anderson

June 22, 1942 - May 7, 2023

Ann Toni Michelle Anderson (nee Jenkins) was one of 3 children born to Cree Boycelta Linze and Eddie Jenkins. Toni, as she preferred to be called, was born in Painesville, OH on June 22, 1942, and died at the VITAS Hospice, Methodist Hospital, Dallas on May 7, 2023. Toni resided in Grand Prairie, TX.

Toni graduated from Humboldt High School, Humboldt, KS. Toni met her future husband, when he relocated to Painesville, OH where he worked as a postman following his discharge from the military.
