Barbara Alice McCune, 92, of Chanute, Kansas, passed away at Credo Senior Living in Chanute, Kansas, on Tuesday, August 27, 2024.

Barbara was born on February 11, 1932, to Harold and Blanche (Endsley) Neptune. Barbara graduated from Chanute High School with the class of 1949. She then attended Chanute Junior College, earning her Associate degree in 1951. On June 15, 1952, Barbara married her high school sweetheart, Larry Lamont “Monty” McCune. The two were married 65 years before his passing in January, 2018.

Barbara was a member of Westview Southern Baptist Church since 1968. Barbara was very active in the church and served in multiple capacities. She taught Sunday School, taught Vacation Bible School, directed the children’s choir, directed the adult choir, served as church clerk, and played the organ for 50 years. In addition, Barbara participated in the orchestra for several Chanute Community Theatre productions.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Larry Lamont “Monty” McCune, son, Mark McCune, parents, and brother, Robert Neptune.
