Douglas William Barnow, 67, passed away at Neosho Memorial Regional Hospital in Chanute, KS on April 2, 2019. He was born on March 1, 1952 in Chanute to Charles William and Mary Fay (Edwards) Barnow. Doug was a loving husband, dad, and grandpa who was easy-going, never met a stranger, always willing to help others, and preferred staying busy over sitting still. 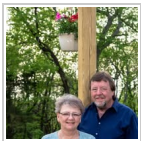

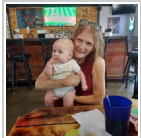
