



Ella Mae (Lindquist) Chapman

Ella Mae (Lindquist) Chapman passed away on Jan. 9, 2015 at Diversicare of Chanute; she was 77 years old. Ella was born on Sept. 28, 1937 in Erie, KS; the daughter of John Theodore and Eunice (Brown) Lindquist.
