In her spare time, Jill was a very talented piano player who could play nearly any song by ear, enjoyed working outdoors, climbing trees and roofs, and baking and cooking. She was especially known for her cinnamon rolls, pies, chicken fried steak, and chicken fried chicken. Jill was a founding member of the Bedford Christian Church in Bedford, TX and brought all six of her children
