Emma Irene Noland, age 95 of Longton, Kansas died Friday, September 29, 2017 at Fredonia Regional Hospital. Emma was born on February 21, 1922 in Udal, KS the daughter of Cecile Anthony and Emma Pearl (Ashworth) Busch.
