Frank Weiner, 91, of Humboldt, passed away peacefully Wednesday, March 13, 2024 in Chanute, Kansas.

Frank was born in rural Chanute, Kansas on August 2, 1932, the son of Thomas M. and Ellen M. (Broadbent) Weiner. He was raised east of Humboldt on the family farm. He attended Allen County Schools through the eighth grade and later earned his GED. He served his country in the United States Air Force during the Korean War where he met the love of his life; Patricia; while stationed at Chanute Air Base, Illinois. Frank was very supportive of his local community. He donated to the local food pantry and local thrift stores. After the military, he worked for IMP boats in Iola for almost 20 years and enjoyed delivering boats around the country. Later he worked as both a farmer and as a drilling contractor, being co-owner of WaY Drilling Company. He was a man, who loved his family dearly. He had a quick wit and easy laugh. He believed in
