Jack D. Wilson, age 86, passed away at Neosho Memorial Regional Medical Center in Chanute, KS on January 9, 2015. Jack was born on November 21, 1928 in Chanute, KS; the son of Melvin and Verga (Mayfield) Wilson.

On July 18, 1948 Jack married Phyllis Gahman in Chanute and they had four children together. Jack served in the Army from 1952-1953 and in the Korean War. Jack was employed at Ash Grove Cement and worked there for 46 years before retiring. He was a member of the American Legion Post 170, VFW and served on the American Legion Honor Guard. He was also a member of the First Christian Church in Chanute. Jack enjoyed playing golf, hunting and woodworking. When he was younger, he enjoyed dirt racing west of Chanute. Jack was known as the "Tootsie Roll Man" and he will be greatly missed.

Jack was preceded in death by his parents; a son: Kevin Wilson and a brother, Gilbert Wilson.

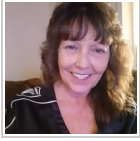
