James "Jim" Clifford Hunt, II, a beloved father, brother, uncle, and friend, passed away peacefully on June 3, 2025, at the age of 72. Born on August 30, 1952, in Wichita, Kansas, to James and Roberta (Goodway) Hunt, Jim's life was a testament to his hardworking spirit and love for family and friends.

His early years were marked by the family's travels as his father worked in construction, eventually settling in Fredonia, Kansas. Jim graduated from Fredonia High School in 1970 and forged a successful career in the construction industry as a welder and heavy equipment operator. 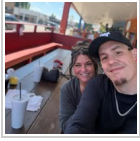
