Kimberly Kay Longpine of Girard, KS passed away on July 26, 2025 in Arma, KS at Arma Health and Rehab.

Kim was active in her bowling league when she met Andy Babcock of Chanute, KS. They were together for 9 years before his passing in 2020.

Kim taught high school math and science in many area schools. She formed strong bonds with her students and coworkers. She loved watching her students play sports, perform music, and even coached scholar's bowl.

One of Kim's earliest memories was being babysat by her horse, Goldie. She grew up on a farm and participated in 4-H. Kim was a fan of the Kansas City Chiefs, Royals, and participated in NASCAR picks with her friends in Chanute.

Once she was unable to bowl, Kim used her knowledge of physics to participate in a pool league.
