Larry Dean Woods, age 71, passed away at Via Christi, St. Francis Hospital in Wichita, KS on Dec. 15, 2014.

Larry was born on March 15, 1943 in St. Paul, KS; the son of R.A. and Daisey (Holding) Woods. He was raised in St. Paul and attended school there and in Stark, KS. Shortly after high school Larry enlisted in the United States Army in 1961, serving until 1964. He then met and married Helen (Bockman) in Enumclaw, WA on Oct. 30, 1965.
