Leslie Rose (Seward) Hayhurst of Humboldt, KS peacefully passed away on Dec. 3, 2014 at Fountainview Nursing and Rehab Center in Rose Hill, KS; she was 72.

Leslie was born on May 12, 1942 in Terre Haute, IN; the daughter of Charles and Virginia (Minor) Seward. Leslie grew up in Terre Haute attending Terre Haute Schools and eventually graduating from Garfield High School.
