



## Lora Lee Wrestler

May 8, 1943 - February 26, 2018

Lora Lee Wrestler, age 74, died February 26, 2018 at her home in Chanute, KS. Lora Lee was born May 8, 1943 at home in Marceline, Missouri to Freda May (Baer) and Lawrence Lavern King. On October 15, 1991 she married Glenn Wayne Wrestler in Marceline, Missouri.

She attended schools and grew up in this small rural town working as a soda clerk in the local retail drug store. After graduation, she worked in several banks in the Kansas City area and for L.T.
