Marla Jean Warren, age 86 of Howard, KS, passed away Saturday, May 6, 2023 at Greenwood County Hospital in Eureka, KS.

Marla was born April 20, 1937 in Springfield, IL to Byron and Eunice (Bloom) Neal. She was raised alongside 3 brothers and 5 sisters.
