Rev. Marvin H. Palmer, age 75 of Fredonia, died Saturday, October 13, 2007 at Fredonia Regional Hospital in Fredonia, KS. The Rev. Palmer was born October 10, 1932, at Ardmore, OK to Charles and Lillie Dove (Cole) Palmer.

He proudly served in the US Army and worked at Barton Salt in Hutchinson before entering the ministry in 1967. He served the United Methodist Church for 25 years, retiring in 1992.
