Marvin Henry Olson, 87, of Chanute, returned to his Heavenly Father Sunday, January 13, 2019 at 8:27 AM.

Marvin was born on August 23, 1931 to Carl and Adeline (Rose) Olson on the family farm west of Chanute. He graduated from Vilas High School with the class of 1948.
