Mary Elizabeth Baker, age 95, a resident of Albuquerque, New Mexico and formerly of Howard, Kansas passed away Monday, February 4, 2013 at the Las Palomas Care and Rehabilitation Center. She was born on June 10, 1917 in Elgin, Kansas the daughter of Cornelius Ray and Roxie Marie (Stroble) Wiseman.
