Melvin LeRoy Miller, age 91, of Moline, Kansas passed away Tuesday, March 19, 2013 at the Pleasant Valley Nursing Center in Sedan, Kansas. He was born on December 25, 1921 in Elk County, Kansas the son of John William "J.W." and Marie Mae (Davis) Miller.

Melvin served his county during World War II in the United States Army Air Corp. He worked as a trackman for Santa Fe Railroad. On September 27, 1943 Melvin was united in marriage to Juanita Maxine Estep in Columbus, Kansas. He was baptized and became a member of the Moline First Baptist Church on December 9, 1934 where he is still an honorary Deacon.
