Michael Franklin “Mike” Kill, age 66, a resident of Moline, Kansas passed away Tuesday, May 21, 2013 at the Robert J. Dole VA Center in Wichita, Kansas.

He was born on December 24, 1946 in Winfield, Kansas the son William Eugene and Verna Anne (Beaty) Kill. He attended St. Mary's grade school and graduated from Moline High School in 1964. During the Vietnam War, Mike served in the United States Army.

Mike was a lifelong cowboy and rancher who had a passion for coyote hunting and also enjoyed team roping with his brother, Tim. Throughout the years Mike hauled cattle and worked as an order buyer in such places as Winfield and Fredonia Sale Barns. He had also worked for the Eureka Downs as an outrider.
