



## Mildred Virginia Millis

June 19, 1931 - November 1, 2023

Mildred “Virginia” Millis, 92, of Neodesha, KS passed away on Wednesday, November 1, 2023, at the Wilson County Medical Center in Neodesha. Virginia was born on June 19, 1931, to James Blaine and Myrtle (Hobbs) Duft and was one of 9 children.
