Nicholas Scott Holloway left the earth unexpectedly on Feb. 11, 2015. Unfortunately he was involved in an automobile accident five miles south of Thayer, KS; he was only 34 years old.

Nicholas was born on Oct. 16, 1980 in Oskaloosa, KS; the son of David K. Holloway and Terri J. (West) Orozco. He was raised by his mother in Chanute, KS attending Chanute schools and graduating from Chanute High School in 2000. Nicholas was a big fan of motorsports, he could often be found at Humboldt Speedway watching the races. He was a reserve fireman while he was in high school; later he was a volunteer fireman in Buffalo, KS. 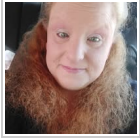

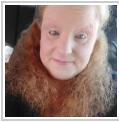
