Randy Jule Julian, age 69 of Howard, KS, ended his earthly journey Thursday, November 3, 2022 due to injuries sustained in a vehicle accident.

Randy was born August 8, 1953 in Winfield, KS to Russell and Jeannie (Tomlin) Julian. He grew up with 3 siblings, and graduated high school in Lakeside, CA.

He proudly served in the US Marine Corp and earned the rank of Sergeant. He enjoyed working for himself and owned his own construction company in North Carolina.
