Richard Blaine "Dick" Scott passed away Sunday, July 28, 2019 in Independence, KS.

Dick was born April 11, 1943 to Blaine and Vivian (Calvert) Scott in Guymon, OK. He began school in Hooker, OK and finished in Borger, TX after the family moved there in 1952. He was an Army veteran who served as a medic at a military hospital in Japan. He helped set up the hospital that was specifically to treat soldiers injured in Viet Nam. After his military service he returned to his work with Ideal Food Stores. He managed several stores in Texas before moving to the Elk Falls, KS area where he worked for Elk County and eventually retired from the Public Works Department. He married Kathleen "Kathy" Hines in 1994 and they made their home in Elk Falls.
