Roger L. Hadlock, age 66, longtime resident of Longton, Kansas passed away Saturday, October 23, 2010 at Via Christi St. Francis in Wichita, Kansas. He was born on January 6, 1944 in Independence, Kansas the son of Ivor Charles and Verna Lee (Thompson) Hadlock. Roger was a graduate of Longton High School class of 1962.
