Roy James Bartram, 72, a resident of Severy, KS, passed away on Monday, June 13, 2022 at KU Med

Center. He was born on August 27, 1949 to Charles and Lorraine (Hense) Bartram in Cleveland, Ohio.

Roy graduated from Cleveland High School and went on to receive an Associates degree from Kansas City Kansas Community College.

children together, 8 of which they adopted from foster care.

He was a greyhound trainer for many years; he loved to bowl and fish and eventually enjoyed all of these activities even more when he was promoted to Papa.
