Timothy (Tim) David Elliott, 66 of Parsons, Kansas, passed away Saturday, March 8, 2025 at his sister's home in Chanute, KS. He was born on December 7, 1958, in Winfield, Kansas, the son of Gerald W. and Glenice A. (Hill) Elliott. The family moved to Parsons, Kansas in 1962, where Tim grew up.
