Tyler "Bud" Linden Kneeland Jr. age 83, of Chanute, passed away Sunday, June 15, 2014 at Neosho Memorial Regional Medical Center. Bud was born September 16, 1930 the son of Tyler and Golda (Green) Kneeland in Joplin, MO.

He graduated from Joplin High School in 1948 and then attended Joplin Junior College. Bud joined the United States Marine Corp in 1947 and served in Korea as a mortar gunner with the 1st Marine Division.

On June 16, 1955, 59 years ago, he married Mary Ann Myers at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Chanute, KS.

Bud received his x-ray training from Jefferson Davis Hospital in Houston, TX, and he served as the department manager for the x-ray department of NMRMC for 29 years.
