Wilbur Craig, 90, of Augusta, Kansas formerly of Severy, Kansas passed away December 10, 2011 at the Susan B. Allen Memorial Hospital in El Dorado, Kansas. He was born on June 1, 1921 in Duquoin, Kansas the son of Issac Roy and Cora L. (Burke) Craig.
